\*\*\*In order to minimize spread and potential contact of the novel COVID - 19 virus, **YORK MEDICAL CLINIC** will be implementing some new schedule changes. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, but will do our best to serve you in this time of uncertainty. We will be temporarily suspending our extended evening clinic hours and will only be open until 6 PM for the time being. We will be offering telehealth appointments and many things can be simply managed over the phone. Our Saturday clinics will be by phone encounter only. We have a nurse and doctor here to answer your questions and will still be available to provide new prescriptions, refills, and take care of the majority of your medical needs. We will continue to suspend our walk-in services during all of this. We would appreciate appointments only, in order to appropriately pre-screen patients. Thank you for your flexibility and understanding during this time. These changes are to minimize your risk of exposure and do our best to keep you and your families safe and healthy.

Updates as of 3/20

\*\*\***YORK SURGICAL** will be postponing and not scheduling" elective" surgeries and procedures as we understand valuable resources like ventilators, masks or hospital staff are resources needing to be on hand for more critical patients.

\*\*\***YORK COSMETICS** have called all appointments on our books regarding rescheduling and again are looking at that date of April 13th for re-booking.

Both businesses will be staffed daily at regular office hours to offer aid to YMC and to screen calls and take emergencies.

\*\*\***YORK GENERAL HOSPITAL** Visitor Policies - Effective immediately, the following guidelines apply to York General Hospital: • Any visitor or support person will be

screened at the main entrance of the hospital according to the centers for disease control guidance • Visitors or support person are limited to one individual per patient. • If you have a scheduled appointment in any department, do not bring more than one visitor or support person with you. • No visitors under the age of 18. • Visitors or support person for our Labor and Delivery patients are restricted to one designated person. • Go immediately to your destination, do not linger in hallways. • Wash your hands frequently • THESE RULES ARE IN EFFECT IN ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE HOSPITAL.

\*\*\***EYECARE ASSOCIATES** is adjusting its hours right now. We will be on a week to week basis until all of this gets smoothed out. We just want to make sure we let as many patients know as possible.

\*\*\***MID AMERICA VISION CENTER'S** UPDATED Policy for Covid-19. As of Tuesday evening, March 17th, the CDC has recommended that all routine eye care be deferred until further notice, in order to slow the transmission of COVID-19

\*\*\***YORK GENERAL** is dedicated to being proactive in preventing the spread of the Coronavirus. Effective Monday, March 16, York General Wellness Center will be closed. This includes all classes and personal training. We will re-evaluate the status of the closing on a weekly basis.

\*\*\*Beginning Monday, 3/16/20, for the safety of our patients and staff, **YORK MEDICAL CLINIC** is temporarily suspending our walk-in clinic. We will still offer same day scheduled appointments. However, we need appts to be made ahead of time so that we can screen for COVID-19 by phone, in order to control the traffic in the clinic before patients enter the building.
