LIFEGUARD)

Qualifications: Applicants must obtain or be able to obtain lifeguard certification upon hiring. Applicant also must be able to pass a series of skills upon interviewing. Previous lifeguarding experience preferred, but not required. Must be at least 15 years of age.

Job Duties: Properly scan the water ensuring safety to all swimmers, enforce all pool rules, and be able respond to emergency situations properly.

YOUTH PROGRAM SUPERVISOR

Qualifications: Youth Program Supervisors need to be caring, helpful and provide excellent supervision of children of all ages while maintaining a positive attitude. Must be at least 15 years of age.

Job Duties: Supervise the participants of YPR's youth programs. Responsibilities could also include: designing youth programs, creating games, crafts and snacks, interacting with the children as they play.

CONCESSIONS STAFF

(for Ballpark Complex and Family Aquatic Center)

Qualifications: Applicant must be able to work days, evenings and weekends. Must be at least 14 years of age. Must be able to perform basic math and count change. Have excellent customer service skills.

Job Duties: Sell concessions during pool hours, complex games/tournaments, maintain a clean work environment.

BALLPARK COMPLEX MAINTENANCE

Qualifications: Must be able to lift 50 pounds and work weekends. Must be at least 15 years of age.

Job Duties: Mow, weed whack, field grooming, chalk fields, custodial duties and equipment maintenance .

PUBLIC WORKS & PARK MAINTENANCE

Qualifications: Must be at least 16 years of age and have a driver's license.

Job Duties: Mowing, trimming, various streets and park maintenance jobs, heavy physical labor should be expected.

ADULT LEAGUE OFFICIAL

Qualifications: Applicants must have playing experience. Actual officiating experience preferred, but not required. Must be at least 16 years of age.

Job Duties: Demonstrate strong leadership skills in problematic situations, follow rules, calm players and spectators.
