



Date: Friday, July 12, 8pm (Arrive early if able)

Location: York Aquatic Center (2222 E 14th St)

Team Limits: Minimum 3, Maximum 4. This is bracket style and different members of your team can play each round.

Game Details:

1. Teams attempt to sink their opponents by throwing water from their buckets into their opponents' boats. The last boat afloat in the final round will win the tournament.
2. Each team will receive four buckets. Teams can distribute their equipment throughout the boat in any order.
3. Players must be in the boat to begin.
4. Teams may engage as soon as the starting whistle is blown.
5. Players may throw water with their buckets, hands, or other materials they've provided at their opponents.
6. When play is paused by an official, all play must stop including throwing water and moving the boat within the pool.
7. There will be a 5-minute time limit for each game. Play will stop once a boat capsizes. If the 5-minute time limit is reached with both boats still remaining we will add an additional 2 minutes of play time.

Restrictions

1. Teams may not physically touch the opposing team's canoes.
 - a. Penalty: Two penalty buckets of water added in your canoe
2. Teams may not physically touch the opposing team's equipment.
 - a. Penalty: Two penalty buckets of water added in your canoe
3. Teams may not physically touch opponents.
 - a. Penalty: Two penalty buckets of water added in your canoe

4. Teams may not swing their buckets at opposing teams
 - a. Penalty: Two penalty buckets of water added in your canoe
5. Players may not touch the side of the pool to push off or direct their boat within the water.
 - a. Penalty: Two penalty buckets of water added in your canoe
6. Players must immediately freeze when an official's whistle is blown. During the stoppage of play all players are prohibited from throwing water at opponents or removing water from their canoes.
 - a. Penalty: Two penalty buckets of water added in your canoe
7. Players who lose equipment in the challenge and are unable to recover the equipment will lose that equipment for the remainder of the round.

Game officials will blow their whistles to stop play when a penalty bucket is issued. They will announce which boat receives the penalty. An official will administer the penalty bucket.

Elimination - A team is eliminated when:

1. Its canoe capsizes.
2. A player falls out, or intentionally leaves their team's boat.
3. It receives more than three penalties.

Once eliminated, the game officials will stop play until the eliminated team and its canoe clear the playing area.

Scoring: Last remaining canoe will be the winner. Bracket Style.

What's provided: Canoes, Buckets, concessions vouchers for each participant for the event.

What to bring: Come in swimwear – you will get wet! Allowed items may include: buckets, water guns, noodles, shields, etc.
